Eagle Crest Golf Club, located in Ypsilanti Township, Michigan, features an 18-hole championship golf course and a three-tiered practice driving range with a spectacular view of scenic Ford Lake. The facility offers a full-service Bar & Grille, including an outdoor patio and a banquet facility room with one of the most picturesque 19th hole settings in southeast Michigan.

Owned by Eastern Michigan University, Eagle Crest is the home course for the Men's and Women's Golf Teams and is also open to the public. The course has locker rooms, a golf shop, and a PGA Teaching Academy on the property along with its state-of-the-art practice facility and a short game area, enabling golfers of all abilities to benefit and to refine their skills.

The course opened in 1989 and was originally designed by Karl Litten of Boca Raton, Florida. In 2012, Eagle Crest underwent major renovations under the direction of architect Jim Lipe. On October 1, 2013, the Eastern Michigan Board of Regents passed a resolution to name the golf course Roy E. Wilbanks Eagle Crest Golf Club. It was through his vision and consistency of commitment that Eagle Crest Resort is such a significant part of the EMU and Ypsilanti community. The par-72 course provides golfers with one of the most challenging yet fair and fun tests of golf in southeast Michigan. With ten sets of tees providing a variety of options and sightlines for all golfers, the course stretches to a length of 7,186 yards, with a course rating of 75.1 and a slope rating of 143 from the championship markers.

Several holes border the banks of Ford Lake, offering beautiful views throughout your round. Those include the course's signature hole, the par-5 16th, which runs along the lake and has a peninsular green. This hole was recently cited by USA Today as one of Detroit's "Dream 18-Most Memorable Holes."

Eagle Crest Golf Club is an excellent value, where you can enjoy golf, food, and drink in a grand setting that continues to receive Golf Digest Magazine's Four-Star "Best Places to Play" rating.



Hosted Bar

This is the most popular way to handle the bar service because it caters to all your guests. They will be able to order the drink of their choice which will be placed on your beverage tab for payment at the end of your event. This option is simple and easy for your guests.



We recommend hosting a bar of some kind for your guests, we understand that doesn't work for all events. We do offer cash bar options with the same selections as the Hosted Bar.



Provide your guests with tickets that they can redeem for beverages during your golf outing. You can select the number of tickets you want to provide, and we will add them to your golf outing package. Eagle Crest Golf Club will provide the physical tickets for you to pass out to your guests at registration.

Cash and Hosted Bars are subject to a \$150 fee per bartender One bartender is required for up to 75 guests Two bartenders are required with more than 75 guests

All hosted bar prices, drink tickets and bartender fees are subject to a 24% taxable service charge and prevailing Michigan sales tax

NOTICE: In accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan, Eagle Crest Golf Club is the only licensee authorized to purchase, sell, or service alcoholic beverages on the premises. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted to be brought on to Eagle Crest property from outside licensed premises, nor are they permitted to leave the premises. ID required.



Event Policies and Guidelines



- 1. DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT DETAILS: A **\$1,000** deposit for any Shotgun event is required sixty (60) days prior to the event. Deposits for Tee-Time events vary based on the number of players, deposit is required sixty (60) days prior to the event. All events are considered tentative until the deposit is received. Payments can be made via Cash, Check, Credit Card or PayPal. Full payment is due on the day of the event. Payments made via Credit Card will incur a non-refundable 2.9% processing fee.
- 2. GUARANTEE OF ATTENDANCE: A final count is required fourteen (14) business days prior to the event. The final count cannot be decreased after this deadline. If the final count is not received by this deadline, the contracted number of guests will be used as the final count. Charges will be based on this final count or actual attendance, whichever is greater. Golf vouchers will be issued on the day of the event if the actual number of participants is less than that of the final count (not to exceed 12 golf vouchers). There will be no cash refunds.
- 3. GOLF CART POLICY: All golf outings will use golf carts and pay for any damage to the golf carts. No more than two (2) people and two (2) sets of clubs per cart.
- 4. PAIRINGS AND EVENTS: All individual and team pairings, along with any special events are required three (3) business days prior to the event. We will make every attempt to accommodate pairing changes made on the day of the outing, but these changes may not be reflected in the posted pairing information or cart signs. Please provide pairings in typewritten form to ensure names are spelled correctly.
- 5. DRESS CODE: Proper golf attire is required, which includes collared shirts, and slacks or shorts. Denim, tank tops, t-shirts and cut-offs are unacceptable.
- 6. SMOKING POLICY: Eagle Crest Golf Club does not allow smoking, vaping or e-cig use inside the facility.
- 7. GOLF OUTING CONDUCT: Proper conduct is expected while on the golf course. Adhere to cart path rules, replace divots, repair ball marks and rake sand traps. Unruly behavior, foul language, golf cart abuse, club throwing and hitting into groups will not be tolerated. Any golfer that chooses not to follow these rules will be asked to leave the premises.
- 8. MENU SELECTIONS: All menu selections must be submitted fourteen (14) days prior to your event. All food and beverage selections are subject to a taxable 24% service charge and prevailing Michigan sales tax.
- 9. FOOD & BEVERAGE: State law requires that all food and beverage must be consumed on the premises and must be purchased from Eagle Crest Golf Club. No outside food or beverages are

permitted, except for specialty cakes (wedding, retirement, shower, and birthday). Food and beverage may not be removed from Eagle Crest premises per Health Code.

- 10. ALCOHOL POLICY: In accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan, Eagle Crest Golf Club, a state-licensed facility, will not serve alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21. The Michigan Liquor Commission directly forbids any alcoholic beverages to be brought onto the premises. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from Eagle Crest Golf Club and served by an employee of Eagle Crest Golf Club. The guests acknowledge the right of our bartenders to suspend the serving of alcohol to any person to ensure responsible drinking. The bar's last call will be at 10:30 p.m. and all functions must end by 11:00 p.m.
- 11. ALCOHOL CONDUCT: Eagle Crest will require proof of the legal drinking age before serving alcohol to any guest. Consumption of alcohol by any person under the age of 21 will be grounds for immediate termination of your event. Excessive alcohol consumption by anyone will not be tolerated and will lead to their removal and/or termination of the function. No refunds. The customer will be liable for all fees and charges related to the event before leaving the premises.
- 12. CUSTOMER CANCELLATIONS: The customer shall provide notice of any cancellation in writing. Golf Outings not cancelled sixty (60) days prior to the event will forfeit all deposits. Golf Outings not cancelled thirty (30) days prior to the event will forfeit all deposits and will be subject to a cancellation fee of 50% of the estimated revenue lost (the forfeited deposits will be used towards the cancellation fee.) Cancellation fee and any related taxes are payable within seven (7) days of the date of cancellation. No cancellation fee if the Golf Outing is rescheduled within ninety (90) days of the original booking date.
- 13. EAGLE CREST CANCELLATIONS: Eagle Crest Golf Club reserves the right to close the golf course due to inclement weather, lightning, or unplayable course conditions. If Eagle Crest needs to cancel the Golf Outing, the customer may reschedule or be reimbursed 100% for all deposits and payments made. There will be no cash refunds.
- 14. NO SHOW POLICY: Individuals and groups who fail to arrive for designated tee times and have not provided cancellation notice, will forfeit their deposit, any payments, and will be charged in full for all booked tee times.
- 15. DAMAGES OR REMOVAL OF PROPERTY: The customer is responsible and shall reimburse Eagle Crest for any damage occurring to the property of Eagle Crest by a client, their guests, or contractors. The cost of any damages will be added to the customer's bill and billed to the credit card on file.
- 16. Eagle Crest Golf Club is not responsible for any items left on the premises that are lost, stolen, or damaged prior to or following the event. This includes items (signs, decorations, etc) brought in by the customer.
- 17. EAGLE CREST GOLF CLUB: Reserves the right to inspect and control all functions held on the premises. All state and local laws governing the purchase and consumption of food and beverage will be strictly enforced. If Eagle Crest observes any activity that may be illegal or inappropriate, or that may result in harm to people or Eagle Crest property, Eagle Crest has the right to cancel the outing, in which case all Golf Outing guests must immediately vacate the premises. The customer will be liable for all fees and charges related to the function before leaving the premises.
